
#### **REGGIA DI VENARIA:**

## **BAR "AL BICERIN":**

#### **MOLE ANTONELLIANA:**

is the symbol of the city, it was the highest brick building by Alessandro Antonelli in the world at the time of its completion but now is the tallest building. Today it is home to *national cinema museum*.
