is the oldest and smallest caffè.
It opened in 1763. It is the home of
the "bicerin", is a hot drink with 3
layers, one espresso, one chocolate,

highest brick building by Alessandro
Antonelli in the world at the time of
its completion but now is the tallest
building. Today it is home to
national cinema museum.
